We Want You to GET CAUGHT READING! - REMINDER

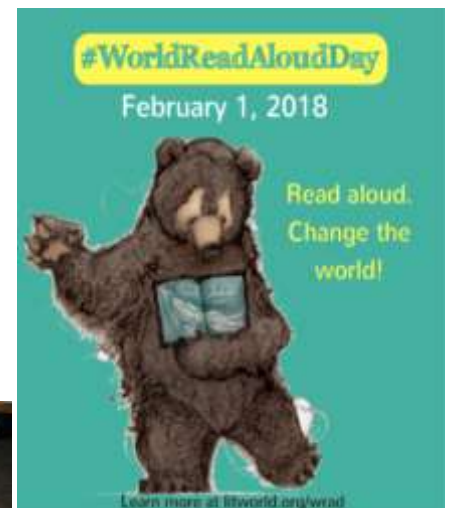
We've had some super pictures sent into school this week, they are all on our display board and many have been published on our Facebook page. Keep sending them in.
