IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL PARENTS

NUT ALLERGIES

Would all parents please be aware that we have children and staff with nut allergies. Please refrain from sending food into school that contains nuts.

LUNCH MONEY PAYMENTS

Can we take this opportunity to remind parents that school lunches must be paid in advance. School lunches cost £2.30 per day (£11.50 per week). Lunch money can be paid using Parent Pay our secure online payment system or by Pay Point at any participating store. Please note any payments made in store using Pay Point may take up to 48hours to register on our system, we advise you keep your receipts as proof of payment.

Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to a free school meal under the Universal free school meal scheme. If you would like your child to take a school lunch, they will need to inform their class teacher in a morning when the lunch register is taken.

P.E. KITS

Children need to ensure they arrive with their PE kits every Monday. School P.E kit consists of a plain round neck t-shirt in house colour, black shorts and black pumps.
