★	Year 6	Ayrton for always showing the Doxey Values, he always shows pride in everything he does.



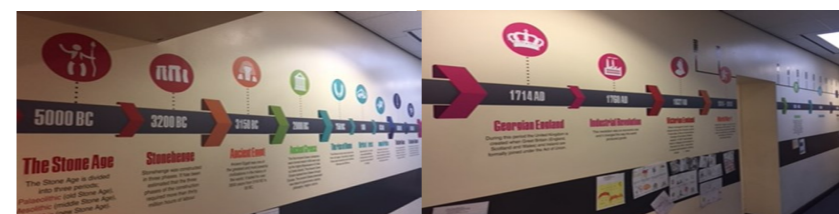

MEDICINE POLICY (NOT INHALERS)

We would like to remind parents that **NO** drugs or medications are administered by school staff, and drugs and medications are not kept in school.

Parents of children requiring antibiotics or other short term medication are advised to request three times a day medication from their GP. If this is not possible, they are requested to come in to school at lunchtime to administer medication to their own child.

We have had a number of children arrive in school with throat sweets and cough medicines in their bag, for health and safety reasons this also is not allowed, as this may cause harm to others if they are consumed in any amount.

If there are long term requirements for medication then specific cases will be discussed with the SENCo and a Care Plan will be set up.

Many apologies, there was a typing error in last weeks newsletter. Please note that parents are liable for a penalty notice if your child has been marked with a “U” (Unauthorised absence) on 20 or more occasions not 10 or more occasions as stated last week. Please see amended statement below.

IMPORTANT

Any child arriving at the school office at 8.55am or after will be marked with late, using an “L” code in the register. Any child arriving after the registers are closed at 9.15am will be marked as an unauthorised absence and marked with a “U” code in the register. If this happens on **20 occasions or more**, you will be liable for a penalty notice which is issued by the local authority.
