Trip to Ancient High House – Friday 20th January 2017

To coincide with the current Year 1 and 2 IPC topic “Buildings” we have arranged a trip to the Ancient High House in Stafford. The children will be taken on a “Time Walk Tour”. The period room in the High House provides a unique opportunity to study social history from the Tudors to the Edwardians. The children will learn about: food; clothing; health; hygiene and home life through the ages. There will be a chance for children to dress in period costumes as well as experience hands-on workshop activities, including “Wattle and Daub” where children will work together, using medieval methods of construction, children create their own section of a wattle and daub wall.

Children will all need a packed lunch in a disposable bag (no glass bottles please). If you are in receipt of free school meals and you would like the school to provide a packed lunch please fill in the form below.

All children must wear full uniform and weather appropriate outdoor clothing as children will be walking to the venue.
